FOREWORD

Dear Partners,

The central objective of the Executive and Legislative authorities of ATU Gagauzia are the stimulation of business development and the attraction of investments to the region, realizing that only by developing the economy through domestic and foreign investments can create jobs, increase revenue, develop social infrastructure, and standards of living.

The Executive Committee of Gagauzia pays constant attention to the activities of businesses in the autonomy and builds a constructive dialogue to identify the solutions of any issues by initiating and adopting regulations to encourage entrepreneurial activity and investment in the region. The building blocks for such an enabling policy are the openness of the region to domestic and foreign investors, improving the business and investment climate, and the creation of preferential conditions for attracting investments to the main sectors of the region.

The Gagauz autonomy has the authority to adopt its own legislation in order to implement economic reforms and to stimulate investment activity. On the initiative of the Executive Committee, the People's Assembly of Gagauzia adopted the «Investments Law».

Foreign and domestic enterprises that decide for an investment in Gagauzia and open work places may take advantage of the regional law on investment, obtaining grants in-kind, preferences on taxes, investment subsidies for construction and installation works, for the creation of industrial and technical infrastructure as well as for the purchase of equipment.

Gagauzia is an integral part of the Republic of Moldova, with functioning preferential trade regimes with the CIS and the European Union. On 23 June 2022 the European Council decided to grant EU candidate status to Moldova, following the recommendations of the European Commission on 17 June 2022. Moldova applied for EU membership in early March 2022, and were granted EU candidate status in record short time. Previously Moldova was the party to the EU Association agreement. On 1st November 2016, a comprehensive free trade regime with the Republic of Turkey came into force. Free trade area regimes offer excellent opportunities for investors by expanding their activity to Gagauzia. Investors can profit from trade opportunities in a 360° perspective.

It is also important that Gagauzia has a favorable geographical location, natural and climatic conditions, modern logistics and infrastructure, and advanced legislation for the implementation of investment projects. The Authorities of the autonomy and the whole Gagauz nation are open for a mutual beneficial cooperation and efficient development of new opportunities.



Q LOCATION

Situated in the southern part of the Republic of Moldova, Gagauzia is bordered by the Ukrainian district of Odessa to the East and has administrative border with districts of Leova, Cantemir, and Cahul to the West. By car, it takes 1.5 hours to travel from the capital of Gagauzia, Comrat, to the capital of Moldova, Chisinau. Its location in the South of Moldova is close to the Danube ports of Giurgiulesti (International Free Port, Moldova), and to the river ports of Galati (Romania), Reni and Ismail (both Ukraine).

Leading industries in Gagauzia are agriculture and food processing (wine making and production of canned fruits and vegetables), textile, apparel, and footwear. Gagauzia is well known for its agricultural potential and traditions for decades, defined by common multicultural values in the region.


A total of 6,433 companies, of which 3,429 are the companies registered as legal entities, and 2,663 individuals, are registered in all economic sectors of Gagauzia. Circa 232 enterprises with foreign share ownership are registered in Gagauzia. In 2022, 232 economic operators, of which 17 are with foreign ownership, were registered in the Authonomy. Products, works and services amounting to 2572,8 million MDL (in current prices aprox. 129,3 million EUR) were produced in 2022, which is 22,9% more than in the same period of the previous year.

In the total volume of industrial production produced in the region since the beginning of 2022, the share of enterprises of the Ceadir-Lunga district amounted to - 44,1%, where the volume of production amounted to 1134,8 million MLD and increased by 10,3% compared to the same period in 2021; the share of the Vulcanesti region is 24,8%, or 638,4 MDL, where the growth of volumes by 20,5% was achieved. The enterprises of the Comrat region produced 31,1% of the total industrial output of Gagauzia, or 799,7 MDL, where the volume of production was reduced by 49,7% compared to the same period in 2021.

The cost of products shipped from the beginning of the year by industrial enterprises with the main industrial activity amounted to 2271,4 million MDL (in current prices). Of the total amount of shipped products, 64,8% (1470 million MDL) were exported 35,3% of products or 801,4 million MDL were sold on the domestic market.

In 2022, the income from sales of industrial products of enterprises covered by the monthly statistical survey amounted to 3166,1 million MDL, which is 14,3% more compared to the corresponding period of the previous year. Gross agricultural output in all categories of farms in 2022, according to preliminary estimates, amounted to 2177,0 MDL at current prices (109,4 million euros), which is 33,5 times more than the level of the previous year.

Export by destination, 2022 (%)



COMPETITIVE ADVANTAGE OF THE FREE TRADE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE REPUBLIC OF MOLDOVA AND TURKEY

The FTA signed by the Republic of Moldova and Turkey, entered into force on November 1st, 2016, provides competitive advantages for both sides. The current situation stated in the table below, describes the actual trade relations between Turkey and Russia, regulated by the specified import rates. Starting with November 1st 2016, the Republic of

Moldova can act as a trade and production mediator between Turkish and Russian companies, as Turkish companies residing in the country will have the opportunity to export to Russia tax-free.





TOP REASONS TO INVEST IN GAGAUZIA

Multilingual population



Gagauzia offers a qualified and multilingual workforce, due to three official languages in the region: Romanian, Gagauzian, and Russian. The State University in Comrat registers an average of 520 graduates yearly. The skilled and multilingual workforce available is highly demanded within the trade regimes/relations the Republic of Moldova is involved in. Servicing and exporting to EU, CIS and Turkey can be done smoothly, customs free and without language barriers.



Special Legal status & cutomized apoproach to investors

According to the Special Legal status, Gagauzia is an autonomous territorial unit (ATU) with decision power in the economic and fiscal areas.



Job creation subsidy

Adopted on August 9, 2016, the Investment law in Gagauzia establishes incentives for investments from MDL 5 million (creating at least 10 jobs), while guarantying investment protection and support.



Free Economic Zone

FEZ «Valkanes» and its subzones in the cities of Comrat and Ceadir-Lunga offer further preferences, including a reduced Corporate Income Tax (CIT) of 6%, customs office on site operating 24/7, 0% VAT on equipment imported etc.



In the process of implementation the IT Hub project in Comrat (KIT HIB).

This is a common co-working center for IT companies with an area of 7200 sq. meters. include modern offices, coworking, conference rooms.



Communication Infrastructure

Communication infrastructure in Moldova, including Gagauzia, is at high performance level, achieving excellent coverage in both wired and wireless communications. Landline is available in most settlements, nonetheless the amount of mobile subscriptions is growing very fast compared to the landline.

INVESTMENT OPPORTUNITIES & PREFERENCES

Law on Investments in Gagauzia

This law defines the legal and economic framework for investment preferences, guarantees the protection of investor's rights, defines measures to support investments by public authorities, and provides arbitration of investors involving disputes.

Investment incentives



Investment subsidies – reimbursement of up to 30% of investments but limited to 5 million MDL (ca. 250 000 EUR) of the actual costs for construction and installation works, purchasing of equipment without VAT;

Reimbursement is made in the following order:

- a) with actual expenses from 1,000,000 lei to 2,000,000 lei, 10% is reimbursed;
- b) with actual expenses from 2,000,000 lei to 3,000,000 lei, 20% is reimbursed;
- c) with actual expenses of 3,000,000 lei and more, 30% is reimbursed, but not more than 5 million lei.



Job creation subsidy - provision of **20 000 MDL** (ca. 1000 EUR) **for each new created job**. The main criteria is **to create 10+ jobs** in manufacturing industry;



Agricultural subsidies (additional to national subsidies) – reimbursement of procured agricultural equipment and technological re-equipment, planting material, procurement of breeding animals from certified farms.

Investment preferences are applied in the following areas: Manufacturing, Agri-Food & Livestock, Infrastructure, Energy efficiency and Renewable energy sources, Informational Technologies, Tourism and Hotel services.

BUSINESS START-UPS

Business incubator in Ceadir-Lunga

Founded by the Government in 2014, the business incubator supports young entrepreneurs and start-ups by a series of measures:

- providing office premises and production facilities for rent for
 - ➤ 30% of the market price in the first year;
 - ➤ 50% of the market price in the second year;
 - ➤ 80% of the market price in the third year;
- > granting loans up to MDL 60,000;
- > providing consulting services free of charge of it's residents.

Currently, the business incubator in Ceadir-Lunga sums 17 residents, 11 being active in manufacturing sector and 6 in the services, creating an overall number of 85 jobs. As of today, there is a total area of **474 m**² of available office space for future residents

Innovation center in Comrat



Innovation Center "Innocenter" in Comrat

Innovation Incubator "Innocenter" in Comrat – founded by the Comrat State University in 2012, in order to increase the competitiveness of the Gagauz region by developing small and medium enterprises (through technology transfer and marketing services, while building business relations to potential investors). The incubator has 5 registered residents:

- **GOLIAT-VITA SRL** Production of equipment designed for efficient use of wood products in furniture manufacturing.
- **SC TOMAI-VINEX SA SAÎ** Implementation of the innovative energy saving technologies for high quality wines production;
- SC AZAMET-PRO SRL Implementation of the innovative grape pomace processing technologies, non-waste principle production in the wine industry
- MAJOR-AUTO SRL Study on modernizing the cheese manufacturing technologies;
- Mellang & Co SRL Development and implementation of the production processes for goat milk ice cream manufacturing, with increased nutritional and biological value.

EDUCATION

Well educated graduates are available to work in companies and increase their productivity.

Russian is the study language in all educational institutions in Gagauzia, though Gagauzian and Romanian are taught as compulsory languages. English and German languages are taught as foreign languages.



The State University of Comrat is organized into four faculties with a 4 year cycle study. As of 2022, the total number of students in Comrat State University is 1773. The University prepares highly qualified specialists in the field of economics, law and agriculture. During the 2020 - 2022 academic year Comrat University reported 487 graduates. Foreign languages department of Comrat University offers study of Gagauzian, Romanian, English, German, and Greek.



Two Colleges: The total number of graduates in College of Comrat and Agriculture Technical College in Svetlii vilage in 2022 academic year was 257. The colleges offer studies of the following specialties: agronomy,

accounting, transport, agricultural mechanization, tourism, agricultural technology.

In 2021, started the construction of an industrial college named Recep Tayyip Erdogan. Specialities: information technology (IT), systems and programming; maintenance of electrical and electromechanical equipment; Electronics and mechatronics, in 2023 will be the first enrollment year.



Three vocational schools in the cities of Comrat, Ceadir-Lunga, and Vulcanesti offer studies in specialities such as: seamstress, carpenter, mechanic, electrician, plasterer, carpenter, builder/constructor. A number of 289 students graduated during 2021-202 academic year.



Professional Training Center has branches in 7 localities, where students are being trained in: wood carving, mechanics, seamstress, accounting, cosmetics etc. The total number of graduates in 2021 was 195.

DUAL VOCATIONAL EDUCATION TRAINING


The dual vocational education and training, also known as dual VET, is highly recognized worldwide due to its combination of theory and practical training embedded in a real-life work environment.

Apprentices in dual VET spend around 30% of training at a vocational school and the other 70% at a company where vocational training is held under real-life working conditions.









FREE ECONOMIC ZONE "VALKANES"



FEZ "Valkanes" was established in 1998. It is located in Vulcanesti city and includes two subzones in municipalities of Comrat and Ceadir-Lunga. The total area of FEZ "Valkanes" is circa 200 hectares, namely in Vulcanesti City - 107 hectares, Comrat Municipality - 35.5 ha, and Ceadir-Lunga Municipality - 42 ha.



FEZ "Vaklanes" is located in the proximity of 7 km to the East from the City center of Vulcanesti. The FEZ has immediate connection to European road E584 connecting the cities of Poltava (UKR) and Galati (ROU). The zone is delimited to the East along the railway route connecting Vulcanesti with Chisniau and Black Sea port on Danube River. Out of the total area of the two subzones in Vulcanesti (107 ha), circa 20 ha represents free buildable area on greenfield.



Ceadir-Lunga subzone is located in the northern part of Ceadir-Lunga Municipality in the proximity of 3 km from the city center. The greenfield land plot of 42 hectares is situated in immediate proximity to the existing industrial zone of the municipality.

The subzone has connection to National roads R36 (Basarabeasca – Ceadir-Lunga – Taraclia) and R37 (Ceadir-Lunga – Comrat – Cantemir), and railway route connecting the municipality with Basarabeasca (railway customs crossing point with Ukraine) and Blank See port on Danube River.





Comrat subzone is located in the northern part of Comrat Municipality in the proximity of 4 km from the city center. The subzone has immediat access to European road E584 connecting the cities of Poltava (UKR) and Galati (ROU). The land plot area is 50.3 hectares.

The main resident of the subzone is Fujikura Automotive MLD - an international supplier of automotive cables for the automotive industry. About 40 hectares of the subzone is free for the construction of production facilities.





To improve the investment climate, I consider it is necessary to make decisions on granting tax incentives («tax holidays») in the first years of activity for new investors at the level of the Executive Committee and the People's Assembly of Gagauzia. We need a strong legislative framework to support investors, especially manufacturing enterprises.

We plan to expand the business in Gagauzia.

In the near future we plan to open in Comrat a company for processing agricultural products. Planned investment is around 2 million euros. The number of jobs will be about 120-150.
